The geocache application will then be checked and a decision on whether to approve/reject the geocache will be made or we will contact you to discuss modifying the proposal to a more suitable location.

You must not place the geocache until permission has been granted by the DWT.

Step 3: Permission granted

When permission has been granted by the DWT your application form will be emailed to you. Please forward it to the geocaching reviewer Lindinis (lindinis@btinternet.com) so your cache can be reviewed.

You may now place your geocache.

- 1) The location of the geocache must be discussed and agreed with Devon Wildlife Trust before any item is placed on a nature reserve.
- 2) Geocaches remain the responsibility of the owner placing the geocache. Geocaches must be adequately maintained and removed when no longer required.
- 3) Devon Wildlife Trust retains the right to terminate this permission without notice and may remove the geocache if necessary.
- 4) Devon Wildlife Trust may require the owner of the geocache to relocate the geocache.
- 5) Geocaches must be placed with respect to the sensitive nature of nature reserves and in such a way to avoid damage or disturbance, eg not placed where a searcher could cause damage or disturbance through their search.
- 6) Geocaches will be placed in locations avoiding safety hazards for searchers and notifying searchers of any safety considerations on the geocache webpage.
- 7) The owner will ensure that the geocache is well maintained, eg
 - a. that it does not pose a threat to wildlife or
 - b. contain food/soap which might attract wildlife or
 - c. that it does not contain matches, lighters, alcohol, knives or anything undesirable should a young child accidentally discover it
- 8) Devon Wildlife Trust accepts no liability for the geocache, its contents or visitors to its property who may be visiting the geocache.
